Little Red Comes Back to Life

Chariman and CEO Craig Jackson is a serious automotive enthusiast and that passion for cars and their history was on full display at the Scottsdale Barrett-Jackson Collector Car Auction earlier this month.

This Shelby prototype GT500 EXP is considered one of the "Holy Grail" of lost collector cars, the car dubbed [Little Red](#) is the only GT500 coupe built by Shelby American. It is the only GT ordered with and factory-equipped with dual-quad carburetors.

The car was assumed destroyed after many had searched for it since it went missing in the 1960s. Jackson and classic car restoration specialist Jason Billups discovered the car in 2018. The car was found in North Texas where it had been owned by the same person for the last twenty years. It is considered one of the most significant finds in American car collector history.

The announcement was made at the Woodward Dream Cruise in Dearborn, Michigan in August of 2018. "Finding Little Red is the discovery of a lifetime," said Jackson. "This Shelby prototype has been one of the most sought-after and elusive vehicle in postwar history...we intent to meticulously restore this legendary car back to its original glory."

Jackson and his team did just that. Little Red in all its glory was [on display](#) along side Jackson's 1968 Shelby GT500 experimental prototype known as the "Green Hornet" and his his one-of-a-kind Candy Apple Green and Rapid Red 2020 Shelby GT500 vehicles.

Seeing these cars on display you could see the impact those early cars had on the new ones and it was a real treat.
